- The WTP Pageant staff, Teays Valley West Middle School and the Village of Commercial Point, Ohio are not responsible for any accidents before, during or after the pageant. Nor are they responsible for any lost, stolen, or damaged items that belong to contestants and anyone associated with them.
- All judges' decisions are final and cannot be disputed. There will be **NO REFUNDS for any reason.** Competition scores are cumulative and continue to build after each event. The winner is the contestant earning the highest cumulative point total across the Personality/Introduction, Casual Wear and Formal Wear categories in their age group.
- Good sportsmanship is expected at all times. Disruptive behavior or defamatory verbal/written remarks against other contestants, judges or pageant staff before, during, or after the pageant from the contestant, or anyone associated with the contestant, may result in disqualification, removal from the premises, and forfeiture of any and all prizes and awards won.
- All issues related to the Code of Conduct and consequences for violation thereof shall be determined solely and exclusively by the Dream Star Pageant staff.
- **No makeup is to be applied on girls 12 and under. Clear lip gloss is fine. Makeup on girls 13 and up must be age appropriate. In addition to the makeup policy, there will be no hair pieces, flippers (fake teeth) or excessive tanning products allowed on any of the contestants. Hairpieces or dental work for medical reasons is fine. This is a natural pageant and heavy point deductions will occur if there is a violation of these rules. It is the Pageant Staff's discretion to do checks to determine if a violation has occurred.**

Directions to Teays Valley West Middle School:

VERY IMPORTANT: Do not use your GPS directions. You will get lost. Follow the directions below.

Coming from downtown Columbus

Take Interstate 71 south to exit #97 (OH665-London Groveport Rd)

Turn left onto OH665-London Groveport Rd. (turn right if coming from Cincinnati or the south).

Go about a mile and turn right onto Hoover Road. (There is a CVS Pharmacy on your right. That's where you turn right).

You'll drive for about 5 miles in a country setting and the road will dead end at a stop sign. At the stop sign, turn left onto OH 762.

Drive about another mile into Commercial Point and road will dead end at a stop sign. (There's a gas station on your left, a bank on your right).

At the stop sign, turn right onto West Scioto Street.

You will see the sign for Scioto Elementary School on your right. Turn right and follow the signs back to the Scioto Middle School. You are going to the Middle School, not the Elementary. Both buildings are on the same grounds.

You will enter the door where the school flag is flying.

You will be judged in three areas: Introduction/Personality, Casual Wear and Formal Wear.

- **Introduction/Personality:**

Tiny Tot division will receive a personality score based on their overall disposition while they model their casual and formal wear.

Princess, Little Miss, Preteen, Jr. Teen, Teen and Ms will receive a score based on their presentation of a memorized introduction no longer than 25 seconds in length. You want your personality to shine through in your introduction. Information to include in your introduction is name, age, hometown, and something about you. Use your imagination; but, remember to keep it honest, natural and something that your child would really say. Think along the lines of a commercial.

There will be an onstage question after you model your Casual Wear outfit.

- **Casual Wear:** All contestants are to arrive wearing their dressy casual wear outfits. No jeans. The casual wear outfits are to be "real" clothes that the contestant would wear to church or a nicer event. The outfit can be accessorized; but, accessories must be appropriate for the outfit and the age of the child. A little bit a sequins and rhinestones are appropriate but no full glitz costumes. Modeling style is fashion show/runaway modeling.

- **Formal Wear:** Formal dresses for Tiny Tot can be either long or short.

Full length dresses are required for all other age divisions.
